

SUMMER CLASS POLICIES

Registration is not complete without full payment at the time of registration and please note that there is a \$30 non-refundable fee.

Session 1 Classes begin the week of June 18th and Session 2 Classes begin the week of July 23^{rd.} Each session runs for 5 consecutive weeks. There is no prolating or refunds for missed classes, however, if there is a second class option for your child's age group, he/she may take make-up classes for any missed classes during the course of the summer class sessions.

Classes will be held as long as the minimum enrollment is met. If a class needs to be cancelled, you will be notified before the start of the program and given a refund or credit.

If you need to cancel for any reason, cancellation must be made by Fri, June 15th for Session 1, and Friday, July 20th for Session 2 in order to receive a credit for future classes or partial refund.

Refunds will not be given for loss of interest, family vacations, or illness.

Gustafson Dance reserves the right to remove a student from class for inappropriate and unchanging behavior or if the instructor feels the child is not able to participate at an appropriate level for his/her age and class. However, be assured that every attempt will be made to assist a student who may be experiencing difficulties.

We expect students to arrive for class on time and we expect parents to be on time to pick up students. If you have extenuating circumstances, please call the office ASAP at 563-3262 X 1.

The last class is open to parent observation. Other classes can be observed with instructor approval.

Students should use the restroom before class.

Students should bring a water bottle with their name on it.

SUMMER CLASS DRESS CODE

PreBallet Female Dancers should wear a light pink leotard (any style) and pink tights with pink leather ballet shoes and a pink chiffon ballet skirt that is long enough for the dancer to hold on to the edges (usually 10-12 inches). If you don't plan to enroll in our annual program, and you have another color leotard, it is okay to wear that for this program.

Ballet/Jazz Combo Female Dancers should wear a light pink (for 5 year olds or yellow leotard for 6 and 7 year olds (any style) and pink tights with pink leather ballet shoes and a pink chiffon ballet skirt that is long enough for the dancer to hold on to the edges (usually 10-12 inches). They should also have black jazz pants or shorts and black jazz shoes (slip on style is preferred).

Primary Level dancers 6-8 years may wear the appropriate color leotard for her level (yellow for Primary –ages 6-7 and Mint Green for Level 1-8 years) If you don't plan to enroll in our annual program, and you have another color leotard, it is okay to wear that for this program. We also may have jazz or ballet shoes to loan if you only have one of the types of shoes.

Female dancers' hair needs to be pulled back into a ponytail or bun. If hair is short, have the front part pulled back out of the face. No jewelry should be worn. (Small earrings are okay.)

Male Dancers should wear a white or black plain T-shirt with black tights, bike shorts or leggings, and black ballet shoes or jazz shoes for jazz.
